Doctor of Medical Sciences, Professor, Honored Doctor of Ukraine, Honorary Professor of Surgery at George Washington University in the USA.

He is author of more than 180 scientific papers, two textbooks on oncology and five inventions.

Schepotin Igor Borisovich was born on January 1, 1956 in Kiev.

Since 2003 he has headed the Department of Oncology of the Kiev National Medical University. **Schepotin Igor Borisovich** in 1979 graduated with honors medical faculty of the Kiev Medical Institute. After graduating from 1982, he studied at the Clinical residency at the Department of General Surgery at the Kiev Medical Institute. From 1983 to 1985 he worked as a surgeon at the clinic of the Ukrainian Institute of Oncology and Radiology, Kyiv. In 1985 he was elected to the position of junior, and in 1989 - the leading researcher of the department of abdominal oncology of the Ukrainian Institute of Oncology and Radiology. In 1983 and 1986 he took part in the European School of Oncology at the All-Union Cancer Center (Moscow). In 1991 and 1992, he was trained in the Cancer Center. V.Lombardi at the Georgetown University (Washington, DC), in 1992-1993 - at the Surgery Department of the same university. From 1993 to 1994 he worked as the chief researcher of the department of abdominal oncology of the Ukrainian Institute of Oncology and Radiology. From 1994 to 1997, he worked as an assistant professor of the surgery department at Georgetown University (Washington, DC), and from 1997 to 1999 as an assistant professor at George Washington University (in the same city). In 1999, he was elected Chief Scientist of the Department of Abdominal Oncology at the Ukrainian Institute of Oncology and Radiology. Since 2003 he has been in charge of the Department of Oncology of the National Medical University named after. OO Bogomolets Since 2003 he has been the Head of the Medical Office of the President of Ukraine as well as in 2005 he was appointed Chief Oncologist of the Ministry of Health of Ukraine. From 2006 to 2010 - Member of the National Council for Health at the President of Ukraine. Since 2006 - Chairman of working groups on the development of standards for diagnosis and treatment of cancer patients (Order of the Ministry of Health and Medical Sciences of Ukraine dated May 11, 2006 No. 266/88). In 2008, he was appointed Director of the National Cancer Institute. Since 2008 he has been the Co-Chairman of the Consultative Expert Group "Oncology, Diagnostic and Radio Pharmaceuticals" of the State Expert Center. From 2009 to 2010 - Member of the council on reforming the health care system at the Cabinet of Ministers of Ukraine. From 2009 to 2010 - Member of the Presidium of the Higher Attestation Commission of Ukraine. Since 2010 he has been awarded the title of Honorary Professor of the New York Institute of Vision and Hearing, New York, USA.

For many years, he has been a member of the scientific unions, namely: since 1979 - the Ukrainian Union of Surgeons, since 1980 - the All-Union of Surgeons, since 1981 - the Ukrainian Union of Oncologists, since 1983 - the All-Union of Oncologists, since 1989 - the European Union for the Study of Cancer Society for Cancer Research), since 1993 - American Association for Cancer Research, since 1995 - American Radiation Research Society, since 1996 - North American Hyperthermia Society (North American Hyperthermia Society), since 1997 - American Surgical Oncology Union (American Society of Surgical Oncology), since 1998 - American Society of Surgery of the Gastrointestinal Tract, 2000 - European Society for Medical Oncology (International Gastric Cancer Association). Since 2008 he has been a member of the Association of Directors of Centers and Institutes of Oncology, Radiology and X-ray of the CIS countries. Since 2008, he has been a member of the Presidium of the Ukrainian Medical Association.

He takes an active part in international surgical and oncological congresses (91 oral and 115 poster presentations). The author of more than 310 scientific works, including 4 monographs, 3 textbooks (in Ukrainian, Russian and English) and 6 manuals. About 100 scientific works are published in foreign journals. Author of 41 patent. He is a scientific adviser to a doctoral and scientific supervisor of PhD theses. Since 2005, Chief Oncologist of the Ministry of Health of Ukraine, Honoured Doctor of Ukraine, member of the National Health Care Council under the President of Ukraine. Under the initiative of **Schepotin Igor Borisovich** in 2008, the National Cancer Institute, which he headed, was founded on the basis of the Institute of Radiology and Oncology.

In 2008, the National Cancer Institute became the additional base of the Oncology Department of the Kyiv National Medical University named after O.O. Bogomolets.
